I, _____, acknowledge that I have requested that I be allowed to ride on a Second Harvest Food Support Committee vehicle (“Second Harvest vehicle”), to participate in the pick-up, transportation, and delivery of surplus perishable food and other goods to various recipient social service agencies.

I recognize and acknowledge that, in addition to the hazards and risks involved in motor vehicle transport and use, there may be further risks resulting from the activities of the handling and delivery of the goods and their containers. This may include, but is not limited to, exposure to food and/or food ingredients that have been known to cause allergic reactions in some people with known sensitivities, such as nuts, shellfish, etc. Volunteers with known sensitivities to food and/or food ingredients must inform the Second Harvest Volunteer Coordinator of any and all such sensitivities or allergies prior to being scheduled to participate in Second Harvest vehicle activities, as outlined above. It is the volunteer’s responsibility to take the necessary precautions in the event that he/she may come in contact with a known food allergen (e.g., carry an epinephrine auto-injector and be prepared to use it, if necessary). Second Harvest is not responsible should an allergic reaction take place while said volunteer is participating in Second Harvest vehicle activities, as outlined above.

I agree to accept all such risks whether of personal injury, economic loss, or property damage and to waive any claims that I, or those claiming through me, may have against Second Harvest, any of its employees or agents and to indemnify and save harmless any of them from and against any such claims.

I acknowledge and agree that permission to participate shall be good and sufficient consideration for this waiver and release.
